

Zanzibar

4 days / 3 nights

This exotic destination on the fabled Spice Route is legendary for its beaches as well as its slave trade and pirate history, can be added to any East African safari.

Day 1 - Arrival in Stone Town

Fly from Arusha or Dar es Salaam to Zanzibar (flight not included). Transfer to the Zanzibar Serena Inn, situated on the harbour of remarkable Stone Town. *Zanzibar Serena Inn - B*

Day 2 - Historic Zanzibar

After breakfast take a city and spice tour to learn more about the Spice Island's most famous produce. Return to Stone Town for lunch (not included) then proceed to the market place to witness the vibrant lifestyle. At the fish market the day's catch of exotic fish is on display, ready for auction. Take the short walk to the Anglican Church built in 1874, on the site of the old slave market. Here you can still witness and experience some of the horrific confined areas where slaves were kept awaiting auction. The Church's altar stands on the spot where the slaves were presented for inspection and then auction. Visit the Zanzibar



Zanzibar Serena Inn

Museum then continue past the High Court, State House and Victoria Garden to Africa House Hotel, the former British Club, situated with a beautiful view over the ocean. Stop for refreshments before moving on to Forodhani Park by the old Arab Fort. The historic walk ends by the beautiful House of Wonders, a striking example of architecture from the 1880's. The Palace was the house of Sultan Barghash until the end of the last century. *Zanzibar Serena Inn - B*

Day 3 - The Villages of Zanzibar

Depart early and drive through coconut palm groves, arriving at Jozani Forest, the last remaining patch of ancient forest on the island, harbouring a wide range of exotic trees and palms. Most importantly it is the habitat of the Red Colobus Monkey, a subspecies of the Colobus that

is unique to Zanzibar. After a walk in the forest, continue towards the East Coast of Zanzibar, arriving at Paje, a small, picturesque fishing village, where the local houses are made from white sand and coral stone. Continue along the coast to Jambiani, an extended village situated on a beautiful, mile long white beach. Enjoy a picnic lunch (not included) and swim before returning to Stone Town. *Zanzibar Serena Inn - B*

Day 4 - Departure

Transfer to Zanzibar Airport and flight to Dar es Salaam or Nairobi.

Madagascar

3 days / 2 nights

This three day package showcases the National Park of Andasibe, home of the fascinating lemur. It is a rare opportunity to observe this beautiful creature in its natural habitat. Species include the Brown, Ring-tailed and the largest of the lemurs, the Indri Indri.

Day 1 - Andasibe

On arrival in Antananarivo, transfer to Andasibe through the green luxuriant vegetation of the east. Along the way you will encounter fascinating landscape that includes rice fields, forests, lakes, waterfalls and mountains. Enroute you will see the villages of the Merina, as the Highlanders were known. Stop for lunch at the Reptile and Butterfly farm and marvel at the curious, yet beautiful chameleons. After arriving at your hotel in Andasibe, enjoy an evening walk in the Reserve of Andasibe to observe night active lemurs and other nocturnal animals. *Vakona Forest Lodge - B*

Day 2 - Lemur Island

Following breakfast, visit the Special Reserve of Andasibe where you will discover the many species dwelling in the forest. Your guide will search for the Indri Indri, the largest lemurs on the island. This 810 hectare reserve is unique with its endemic fauna and flora. It contains a wide variety of orchids and fascinating animals such as chameleons and tenrecs, as well as many birds. In the afternoon visit Lemur Island at Vakona Forest Lodge and meet the resident lemurs up close. The rest of your afternoon is at leisure to relax by the pool or participate in optional activities such as horse riding or a visit to the Private Park of Vakona. *Vakona Forest Lodge - B*

Day 3

After breakfast, head back to Antananarivo where your lemur experience comes to an end.
