

WEDDINGS IN MAURITIUS

with Beachcomber Hotels

Wedding Application Information

The following documents are required by Beachcomber at least 6 weeks prior to the wedding date as they are required to complete legal procedures by the Civil Status Office in Mauritius.

- 4 Photocopies of each applicant's Birth Certificate
- 4 Photocopies of the first 3 pages of each applicant's Passport
- 4 Photocopies of each applicant's Death or Divorce Certificates

NB: All wedding documents must be translated in English by an official translator.

The following "Application to Marry" form must be completed and signed by the Bride and Groom and is to be lodged along with all documentation required as stated above.

At least three (3) days before the wedding, the clients will have to go to the Registrar General's office in Port Louis. All original copies of the documentation must be presented and all affidavits will then be checked by the Attorney of Law. The clients then proceed to the Supreme Court to swear their affidavit.

A divorced bride wishing to marry within 10 months of the "Decree of Divorce" must have a pregnancy test (Mauritian Law). If under these circumstances the test is positive, the civil marriage cannot be celebrated in Mauritius. Cost of the pregnancy test is at the client's expense.

Cost of Pre-Paid Wedding Legal Fees: AU\$ 540*

Legal fees are compulsory and are subject to change. Prepayment in AU\$ prior to departure is required.

Legal Fees include:

- Return Taxi fare to Port Louis.
- Affidavit fee and Supreme Court charges
- Civil Status Officer's Fees including transport - WEEK DAYS ONLY
- Administrative charges.

NB: A court translator available for couples who do not understand English at an additional cost (Paid direct in Mauritius)

Important Information About Weddings In Mauritius

Couples proposing to get married in Mauritius must be aware that different laws apply to different nationalities. The forms sent to you by Beachcomber Tours relate to marriages between Australian citizens in Mauritius. Current or former Mauritian citizens wishing to marry either Mauritian or Non-Mauritian citizens, must ensure that they fill in the correct documentation and should seek advice from the Mauritian Embassy to ensure that their wedding can take place in Mauritius on the day nominated. Beachcomber Tours takes NO responsibility for incorrectly filled in forms or documents. Beachcomber Tours' sole responsibility is to ensure that all documentation received in relation to weddings is forwarded to the hotels. Beachcomber Hotels' sole responsibility in respect of documentation is to ensure that all documentation received in relation to weddings is forwarded to the appropriate government department at least 1 month prior to the wedding date as requested by the Mauritian Government. Beachcomber Tours and Beachcomber Hotels are not responsible for mail or courier delays.
